

MUDS 2017 Sponsorship Eligibility

In order to receive sponsorship for tournaments such as Women's, Australs and Worlds, members must be able to show they have achieved 14 points on the table below in the last 12 months. Members who have been in the club for 2 or more years must show at least two points came from category B, while those who have been in the club for 3 or more years must show that at least three points come from category B.

Those who have been members of the club for only one semester are only required to achieve 7 points for sponsorship.

Committee may waive these requirements at their discretion, but as a general rule will not do so unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Category A:

Adjudicate/debate at a 'mini' hosted by MUDS

Attend a MUDS social (1 pt per social)		

Category B:

1 Point Each	2 Points Each	3 Points Each
Give a member training session (either on a Tuesday evening or at a weekend training day)	Debate at Easters	
Debate in the Pro-Am tournament at the start of Semester 2 (1 pt each week)	Lead/debate in a novice team at President's Cup or Victoria Cup (2 pts per tournament)	
Adjudicate in the Pro-Am tournament at the start of Semester 2 (1 pt each week)	Debate at Women's	
Adjudicate at Easters, Women's, President's Cup or Victoria Cup		
Adjudicate at a novice training day		

NB: You cannot obtain points for the same activity just because it falls under different categories e.g. if you lead a team at Victoria Cup you cannot also claim points for attending a mini hosted by MUDS

You CAN obtain points for participating in multiple activities e.g. completing a schools training session is 2 points per session, while debating in a weekly internal competition is 1 point per week.
